Post-Care Instructions for Electrodesiccation and Curettage (Scrape & Burn)

- The site should be kept clean and dry for the first 2-3 days.
- After the first 48 hours, you may get the area wet.
- Gently clean the areas daily with soap and water. You may use hydrogen peroxide to remove any crusted material that does not come off easily.
- Apply Vaseline to the site(s) after the area is cleaned. Anti-bacterial creams or ointments, such as Neosporin or triple-antibiotic, are not needed and are not recommended.
- Do not let area dry out. Do not let it scab! Scabs increase the risk for scarring.
- Cover the site(s) with a band-aid. If the biopsy is on the face, a band-aid is not necessary if you keep Vaseline on the site.
- Call our office if you have any questions or if there is increasing pain, redness, swelling the area becomes “hot.”
