



Post Operative Mohs Surgery Care Instructions

- Leave your post operative bandage in place throughout the night.
- Remove the bandage the following day of your surgery.
- Wash the wound daily with clean water and apply a layer of antibiotic ointment.
 - Polysporin, Vaseline, etc.
- If your wound has external sutures or is open to heal, apply a thin layer of Vaseline or antibiotic ointment twice a day until your next appointment.
- Do not use Neosporin ointment.
- If there is any excess bleeding noticed, hold direct pressure on the site for 20 minutes, this can be repeated if necessary.
- If the bleeding does not stop, calls the numbers listed below or go to the nearest emergency room.
- A small amount of swelling, redness and tenderness is to be expected but if this is progressing then please call us.
